FORM OF PAYMENT: Full payment in USD of the registration fees indicated must accompany this form and must be received at the NACAC office by close of business (4:30 p.m. EDT) on each of the deadline dates indicated or the higher registration rate will apply. Fees are payable to National Association for College Admission Counseling by check or credit card. Credit card payments will appear as NACAC on your billing statement. NACAC will accept registrations by fax only for participants wishing to pay by credit card. **All applicable fees and costs for the national conference must be paid in full at the time of registration. Purchase Orders are not accepted for the NACAC National Conference.**

Cancellation and substitution requests must be submitted in writing. National Conference and preconference workshop refunds are subject to a \$25 processing fee each. Preconference seminar refunds are subject to a \$10 processing fee each. To receive a full refund (less processing fees), cancellations must be received on or before July 19. A 50 percent refund (less processing fees) will be processed if request is received between July 20 and August 15. No refunds will be processed for requests received on or after August 16 or for no shows. Additional Social tickets and contributions to Imagine or the Fund for the Future are non-refundable.
